

Exam Campus Conflict Condition and Procedures

Condition:

1. Students from School of Management, School of Arts, School of Comm. Arts, School of Architecture, school of Music, School of Engineering, Science and Technology who have more than one exam on the same day at different campuses may petition to take all exams for that day the Suvarnabhumi Campus.
2. Students from other faculties may petition to take all exams for that day at the Hua Mak Campus under the same conditions.

Petitions for the Campus Conflict Examination must be submitted to the Office of the University Registrar within the first three weeks (15 working days) of the semester or summer session. Students should retain the “receipt” issued by the Registrar’s office, as it may be required for verification if their names are not included in the “Campus Conflict Examination List.”

The details of the Campus Conflict Exam Schedule will be posted 2 days before the examination period on registrar.au.edu. To check the schedule, simply log in with your username and password, and then click on the “Campus Conflict Schedule” link to view your exam dates and venue information.

1. Students from School of Management, School of Arts, School of Comm. Arts, School of Architecture, school of Music, School of Engineering, Science and Technology will take their campus conflict exams at the Suvarnabhumi Campus. All other students will take their campus conflict exams at the Hua Mak Campus.
2. If one of the requested subjects in the Exam Campus Conflict is withdrawn. Students must follow the original examination schedule for the remaining subject, including the original exam room and time.
